- ▲ Identify verbal direction and de-escalation techniques appropriate for use in the workplace.

Being prepared does not mean being paranoid. Learn practical measures to recognize and respond to aggressive behavior in the workplace.

- ▲ Identify body postures and safety distances that staff may use to afford additional protection when unavoidably confronted with aggressive or violent behaviors.
- ▲ Identify the importance of understanding their organization's policies and procedures relating to managing aggressive or violent situations in the workplace
- ▲ Discuss the importance of incident reporting procedures as they relate to acts of aggression or violence in the workplace.
